### Notes

#### (1) Core Courses (Type 'T')

Core courses are coded (T) as the main course, which provide content and scope in any specialized area or in the major area of interest. Students are required to take and pass these courses.

#### (2) Cognate/Elective Courses (Type 'E')

These courses are coded (E) which will contribute to the academic or professional development of the candidate with respect to the particular need in the area of specialization. It supports the core courses in providing more depth to expand area of specialization, thus allowing more opportunity for the candidate to extend and intensify one's knowledge and expertise in the area of specialization.

#### (3) Course Registration

Full Time : Students are suggested to register 4 courses (16 units) every semester, and start their research work early by the third semester of their study. However, Full-time students are allowed to register at least three courses (12 units) in one semester (subject to the allowed maximum duration of the candidacy).

Part Time : Students are suggested to register 3 courses (12 units) every semester, and start the research work early by the fourth semester of their study. However, Part-time students are allowed to register at least 2 courses (8 units) in a semester (subject to the allowed maximum duration of the candidacy).

#### (4) Adding / Dropping Course

Students are not allowed to adding/dropping the course until after the completion of course registration activity. Adding/dropping of courses are only allowed after obtaining the support of the Lecturer and approval from the dean/Deputy Dean of the school for valid reasons.

Students who drop the course until 2<sup>nd</sup> week can claim a refund of tuition fees. However, dropping of courses are still allowed after 2<sup>nd</sup> week until the 6<sup>th</sup> week without any refund of fees. After 6<sup>th</sup> week, students are not allowed to drop any courses.
